



# Intelligent Green Room

Using the “Intelligent” Green Room may appear challenging, but hopefully this sheet will help you work through it.

Step 1: Open the Lighting Cabinet in the Green Room (current combo: 0718) After you enter the combo, push the lock in - and it will spring open. The computer cabinet section has the same combo.

Step 2: Turn on the data projector, via the top right button on the Epson remote. It takes about 30 seconds to warm up - though looking into the lens you should see it begin to brighten. The projector is currently set to “find” the active input - so you shouldn’t need to make any other adjustments on the projector. Though, if you want to switch it from Computer to Video manually (to switch sources, or if it didn’t “find” what you wanted) use the “source” button on the remote.

Step 3: If you want to use the computer; open that lock, then turn on the computer. When it’s ready, enter your user name (something like “ffkm1”) and your UAF password. Be sure the bottom network logon pull-down says “UAF”. It now has Internet capabilities!

Step 4: Turn on the sound system (Sony, top unit, button High Left). To adjust volume; use the big knob on the right, or use the SONY remote. By default, it’s set to the DVD player - which should work for either the DVD or VHS.

DVD player: “Video 1”          Computer audio: “Video 2”

Step 5: Turn on the DVD / VHS player. That’s the bottom (black) unit in the cabinet; button bottom left.

Use the “Panasonic” remote to control the unit. You may need to press the “DVD / VHS” switch to let it know which part of the device you want to view. I put a combination device there to try to make it easier to use.

## When you’re done:

Step 1: Please be sure to turn off the projector. Lamps for this unit are very expensive (about \$110) so please power it down by putting it in “standby” mode. Epson remote; top right Power button. The machine will ask you to verify this; push the button again to actually power it down.

Step 2: Remove your media (DVD / VHS tape)

Step 3: Turn off sound system and media player.

Step 4: Re-Lock cabinet. Be sure to spin combo after closing it.
